- Bluetooth version 2.0 with CSR Chipset

USING YOUR HEADSET

Before use, charge your headset's battery for 2 hours.

1. Plug the small plug into the charging port of the headset. The larger end should be plugged into any USB port for power.
2. The red indicator light turns on when the battery is charging. It may take up to 1 minute for the light to turn on. When the headset's battery is fully charged (about 2 hours) the red indicator light will turn off.
3. Unplug the charger from the headset.

Low Battery Warning: When the battery is low, you will hear a tone every 2 seconds and the LED indicator light will flash. This will occur about 5 minutes before the unit will shut off.

Note: Headset is not functional while charging. It is recommended for the longest battery life that the first time you charge the headset you charge for 8 hours. This should only be done for the first charge.

TURNING ON AND OFF

To turn your headset on, press and hold the MFB (Multi Function Button) until the indicator light flashes blue, then release the button. To turn your headset off, press and hold the MFB until the indicator light flashes RED twice rapidly and turns off.

To conserve battery power, turn off your headset when don't plan to use it for a while.

USING BLUETOOTH

1. Make sure your mobile phone is on.
2. Your phone's Bluetooth feature is off by default. To use your headset, turn on the Bluetooth feature in your phone.
3. To turn on Bluetooth for most phones: Select (menu) > settings > connection > bluetooth link > setup. Scroll to Bluetooth On/Off. Select Change. Scroll to On. Press select to turn on Bluetooth feature. Bluetooth feature remains on until you turn it off.

Note: These steps are for most phones. For other phones, see your phone's user guide.

PAIR YOUR HEADSET

1. To put headset in pairing mode, turn on the headset by holding the MFB for 6 seconds until the indicator illuminates a constant blue.
2. Set the phone to look for your headset. For most phones: On your phone, select (Menu) > settings > connection > bluetooth link > hands free > search devices. The phone lists all Bluetooth devices it finds. Select device name: GL-IBGS2 Select OK or Yes to pair (link) the hands free device. Enter the password: 0000 and select OK.

When your headset is successfully paired with your phone, the blue indicator light changes from constant to flashing.

Note: These steps are for most phones. For other phones, see your phone's users guide.

1. Test and use. Your phone and headset are now paired and ready to make and receive calls. To confirm they are operating properly, make a call.
2. Place the headset over your ear. See "Wearing the headset."
3. On your phone, dial the number you want to call and press the Send key.
4. If your phone and headset are successfully paired you hear the call on the headset.

After you have successfully paired your phone and headset, you do not need to repeat these initial setup steps each time you use the headset.

WEARING THE HEADSET

You can wear this headset on your left or right ear.

The earhook simply snaps on to the area between the body of the headset and the earpiece. It can be attached for either right or left ear fitting. Loop the earhook over your ear.

Press the headset to your ear.

ADJUST VOLUME SETTING

Adjust vol + / vol – on your mobile phone for proper level.

HEADSET FUNCTIONS

To answer a call: Press the Multi Function Button function button briefly.

To end a call: Press the Multi Function Button briefly.

To reject a call: Press the Multi Function Button for 2 seconds.

To redial last number: Press the Multi Function Button briefly.

To voice dial: Press the Multi Function briefly twice until you hear a voice prompt.

Note: Your mobile phone must support voice dialing for this feature to work.

SUMMARY

Items	Headset Status	Operation
Turn on	Off	Press function 4 seconds
Turn off	On	Press function 4 seconds
Pairing	Off	Press and hold function button 6 seconds
Answer a call	Ringing	Press function button briefly
End a call	Talking	Press function button briefly
Reject a call	Ringing	Press function button for 2 seconds
Redial	Standby	Press function button 1 time
Voice dial	Standby	Quickly Press function button 2 times

TROUBLESHOOTING

Q. My phone does not find my headset.

A. Make sure the blue light on your headset is steadily lit when your phone is searching for devices (see pairing.)

Q. My headset worked before but it's not working.

A. Make sure the headset's battery is fully charged. Make sure your phone is on and the Bluetooth feature is turned on in your phone. If the Bluetooth feature has been turned off or was turned on only temporarily, you may need to restart the Bluetooth feature on you phone. (see pairing.)
